PLANNING FOR SURGERY

- Consult with your physician if you take blood thinners, aspirin, or medication for diabetes.
- You will need a responsible adult to stay with you after surgery, remain at the hospital until you are discharged, then accompany you home.
- **Do not smoke, drink or eat anything, including gum and mints, after midnight** the night before your surgery unless instructed otherwise by your surgeon.
- Take blood pressure, heart, stomach, seizure, or breathing medications with a sip of water the morning of your procedure. Medications to include: _____

- Remove all makeup, jewelry, contact lens, and nail polish before surgery. Wear comfortable clothing that will be appropriate to wear home when discharged.
- Bring a copy of your Living Will and / or Durable Power of Attorney for Healthcare and/or Advanced Care Plan.
- Report directly to the 3rd floor Same Day Surgery/Outpatient Services on the day of your procedure. Enter through the main lobby and take the first group of elevators.
